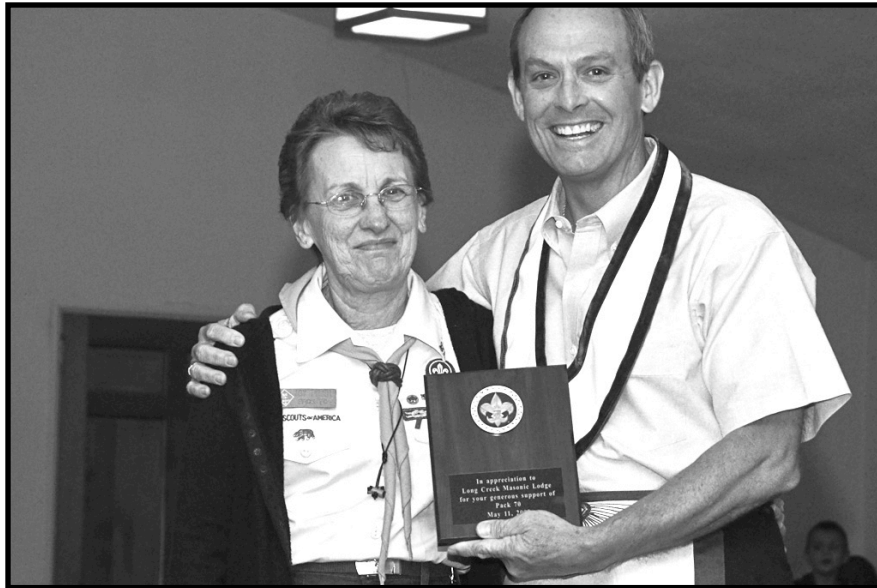

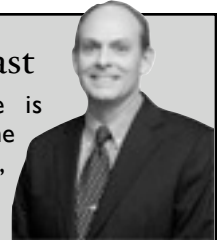
SECRETARY'S DESK
